

Guidelines for sending originals

Online Submissions

Be registered at ECCOM Magazine <<http://fatea.br/seer3/index.php/ECCOM/user/register>>.

Registration in the system and subsequent access or login are mandatory for submission as well as for checking the status of submissions. The Magazine receives works in continuous flow.

Guidelines for Authors

To submit an article to the ECCOM journal, the text must be original, that is, the text cannot have been submitted to another form of publication. There are no costs or charges for submitting or publishing articles. Texts can be typed in Portuguese, English or Spanish. Template at: <

Specialist is the minimum degree for authors as long as there is co-authorship by a master or doctor.

The use of the following ABNT standards is recommended:

- * References - Elaboration (NBR-6023);
- * Citations in documents - Presentation (NBR 10520);
- * Progressive numbering of sections of a written document (NBR-6024);
- * Summary - Presentation (NBR 6028).

Note: for presentation of tabular data, see IBGE standard.

Submission Verification Items

As part of the submission process, authors are required to verify the submission's compliance with all of the items listed below. Submissions that do not comply with the rules will be refused.

The contribution must be original and unpublished, and not being evaluated for publication by another journal; otherwise, it must be justified in "Comments to the Editor".

Submission files must be in Microsoft Word or OpenOffice format. The text must have a minimum of 10 pages and no more than 25 pages.

URLs for referrals should be provided where necessary. The font is mandatory for figures, tables and graphs.

The text must be formatted in single space, in Times New Roman, 12 point font, 6 spacing; use italics instead of underlining (except for URL addresses); figures, graphs and tables must be inserted in the text, not at the end of the document, as attachments.

The text follows the style standards and bibliographic requirements described in Guidelines for Authors.

The identification of authorship of the work must be removed from the file and from the Properties option in Word, thus guaranteeing the criterion of confidentiality of the journal, when submitted for peer review, according to the instructions available in ensuring the Blind Peer Review.

In a separate file, the name of the author (or authors) and a mini-curriculum of at least five lines and a maximum of ten must be sent, containing the institution in which they work, academic title, Lattes link, ORCID number, electronic address and other information that you may consider important.
